



## PREPARING FOR EPR COMPLIANCE

Complying with EPR begins with collecting data related to product distribution in each state and material specifications on packaging. In some cases, this can be complicated and time consuming, potentially involving multiple internal resources, customers, and suppliers.

To initiate the process of joining a PRO or EPR Compliance Agency, the following information should be collected.

- A comprehensive list of all the products a Producer sells within applicable EPR states.
- For each product, compile a list of the different packaging formats (types) used to contain those products.
- For each packaging type, identify and document the materials used as well as their respective weights (e.g., grams or ounces).

The table below is an example of a compiled list:
